OPENING OF THE NEWMAN CENTRE GUELPH



On Sunday, October 30th Bishop Crosby opened the Newman Centre Guelph at a Mass for the dedication of the oratory (i.e. "chapel") and the consecration of the altar. The worship space was blessed with holy water and the altar was covered with sacred chrism. It was a beautiful ceremony filled with rich meaning and symbolism.



After the Mass, two talks were given in the upstairs meeting room: one by the artist commissioned to write the icon of Blessed John Henry Newman (seen in the photo of the choir) and one given by a Newman scholar who explained the text in the icon, that is, "truth cannot be contrary to truth," an maxim Newman used to uphold that there is no contraction between faith and science. The talks were followed by a pizza social.



Now that the student centre is open, I will be celebrating weekday Mass there on Wednesday and Thursday, as well as Sunday Mass in the afternoon. As a result, there will be weekday Mass at Sacred Heart Church on Tuesday evening and Friday morning only until the students leave for the Christmas break.

I would like to thank all of you who prayed for the opening of the building. I now ask you to pray that my ministry at the University of Guelph may be fruitful.
