



# Pastor's Message

## THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (*CORPUS CHRISTI*)

After the Easter Season ends on Pentecost Sunday, the following two Sundays are marked by very special feasts: the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity and the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*). On June 3<sup>rd</sup>, the Vigil of Pentecost Sunday, Msgr. Kroetsch came to our parish to celebrate Confirmations at St. Peter's Mission Church. The church was packed with over 200 people and by all accounts, it was a wonder-




ful celebration. It was both the Birthday of the Church and the sending of these young people into the world to bear witness to our faith just as the Holy Spirit prompted the disciples to go into the streets and proclaim the Gospel that first Pentecost day. On June 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup>, as we celebrate Trinity Sunday, we will reflect upon our own relationship with God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. As we enter into the mystery of the Trinity, let us be mindful that being drawn closer to one divine person is always at the same time being drawn into a deeper relationship with all three persons of the one God. On June 17<sup>th</sup>/18<sup>th</sup>, as we celebrate *Corpus Christi*, we will reflect upon how, if we want to be spiritually fed by the Eucharist, then we need to deepen our commitment to our faith community by deepening your

commitment to the Eucharist. I would like to propose two ways you can deepen your commitment to your faith community and deepen your commitment to the Eucharist on *Corpus Christi* Sunday and in the months to come.

First, I invite you to participate in this year's *Corpus Christi* Procession on Sunday, June 18<sup>th</sup> following the 11:00am Mass at Sacred Heart Catholic School. If you attend the Mass, please plan to spend some time afterwards processing outdoors with the Blessed Sacrament carried in the monstrance. If you attend another Mass that weekend, please plan to arrive at the school around 11:45am in order to join the procession. Just come right into the gym and wait at the back. (If the weather is inclement, we will process around the hallways in the school.) When we follow Christ in the procession with the Blessed Sacrament, we deep our commitment to following him in our way of life as his disciples. If you aren't able to walk in the procession, I ask that you wait in the school gym for the procession to return to the altar. After the Benediction, there will be hospitality at the school sponsored by the CWL.

Second, I invite you to spend sometime in the coming months in Eucharistic Adoration. Each week, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in Sacred Heart Church on Tuesday after the 7:00pm Mass up until the Benediction on Friday before the 8:00am Mass. In other words, Sacred Heart Church is open for you to pray before the Blessed Sacrament from Tuesday evening right around the clock to Friday morning each week. After the *Corpus Christi* Procession, I will be handing out Adoration Gift Cards (see images of the front and back). These cards can be used both by the Adorers who are regularly scheduled to pray for an hour in the church each week and by anyone who plans a Holy Hour of prayer anytime during the week. Prior to your Holy Hour, fill out the back of the gift card and give it the person you plan to pray for on that date. It is a wonderful way to pray for someone who is sick or just needs some prayerful support. It is also a wonderful way to deepen your commitment to your faith community by deepening your commitment to the Eucharist.

Did You Know?

- On special occasions Father Mark walks down the aisle carrying a fancy bucket
- This bucket is called an "aspersorium"
- It is filled with holy water
- Inside the aspersorium is the "aspergillum"
- It has a long handle with a hollow round ball on the end that has holes in it
- Father Mark dips the aspergillum into the aspersorium and sprinkles the people with holy water
- This reminds us of our baptism with water
- This action is called the "rite of sprinkling"
