



POPE FRANCIS' PRAYER INTENTIONS FOR JULY: LAPSED CHRISTIANS

For the month of July, Pope Francis has asked us to prayer for lapsed Christians, the sheep who have strayed from the flock. He asks that we do the following help them to "rediscover the merciful closeness of the Lord and beauty of the Christian life." First we must pray. These are still the Lord's children. They were baptized into the Body of Christ. We must share our concerns with Jesus as he shares his concern with us. We must then act. Don't nag. Actions have always been louder than words. We must share God's merciful love through our own loving actions. Preach by living a merciful and loving life. These actions will show how deep God's love for us is. This life will provide a tangible example of Jesus to those who have gone astray.

AUGUST IS A MONTH OF ONLINE REFLECTION, PRAYER AND LEARNING (from Bishop Crosby's Heart to Heart) for youth ministers in the Diocese, all in view of next year's ministry. Christina Mines, from our Youth Office, invites anyone who ministers to young people (teachers, chaplaincy leaders, pastors, youth ministers, parents, etc.) to participate in "[Kickstart 30](#)". Participants register by email and once each day throughout the month of August they will receive an email with a reflection to think and pray about – providing spiritual and professional nourishment in the summer. MARRIAGE TIP #74 - Pope Francis, in *Amoris Laetitia* (The Joy of Love), challenges married couples to understand that their love is a call to sacrificial love. He invites each spouse to see their married love as love that must be first and foremost self-giving. When a person in relationship understands this, it helps them to reach beyond themselves and indeed grow. When we take the time to discern our vision of married life and then reach into ourselves to make it happen, both spouses benefit. The Pope is reminding us that love may not be perfect, but it is love and when we nurture it from within, we strengthen and build a deep bond between us
