Pastor's Message

BE A GOOD STEWART

Thank you for your generosity. Your offerings provide the financial support needed to operate our current facilities and to plan for building a new church with the funds we've saved over many years. The good news is that we are closer than ever to building a new church that will serve the parish and Camp Brebeuf. By Christmas I hope to show you some conceptual drawings that I and the New Build Committee have been developing with our architect. Although we will need a loan to complete this project, we have enough funds for the down payment. The financial challenge for us will be affording the costs associated with a larger facility. Before he approves the building of the new church, Bishop Crosby would like us to demonstrate that we can financially support the operating and maintenance of the new building. Hence, I need to ask you to consider increasing your weekly offerings. Have a look at the chart below and see where you line up in terms of a percentage of your household income. You may wonder how all these Protestant churches maintain old buildings with small congregations. Well, most of them give 10% of their income to the church. In past, we Catholics have been able to get away with giving about 1% because our congregations have tended to be much larger. However, with declining church attendance and continuing expenses, Catholics throughout our diocese will have to start giving more. Like I said, have a look at the chart and pray -there's even a prayer provided- about whether you might move your percentage one or two columns to the right. Also please consider planned giving. In this bulletin you will find a copy of the Catholic Estate Planning Guide and a brochure which you can use to direct your bequest. Your planned gift would help us ensure that our new church becomes a vibrant centre of worship for generations to come. Be Catholic. Be a good steward. And be assured of my prayers and the prayers of future pastors and parishioners in gratitude for your generosity for generations to come.
